Implement an effective Transition framework!

In this full-day session, participants will explore a framework that supports the systematic structure and inter-agency collaboration to ensure that comprehensive transition programs are effectively implemented.

Participants will:

- Research and explore transition and post-school outcomes.
- Understand the legal requirements for transition service language in Individualized Education Programs (IEPs).
- Increase knowledge about state and federal compliance monitoring of transition language included in IEPs.
- Examine effective practices for working with culturally and linguistically diverse families.
- Understand how to develop and write compliant transition plans.
- Learn how the transition components align and work together to create an effective IEP.
- Determine how to select tools to effectively collect data for transition planning.
- Discover and explore transition assessments.
- Identify community programs and post-school options, learning how to access transition resources for students.
